Work will continue in both schools to cement our new link.



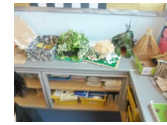

Please be reminded that for reasons of hygiene and health and safety, no dog **of any size** is allowed anywhere in school including the yards, pathways and foyer.

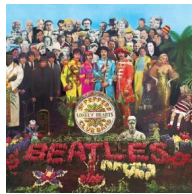


Dear Parents/guardians,
