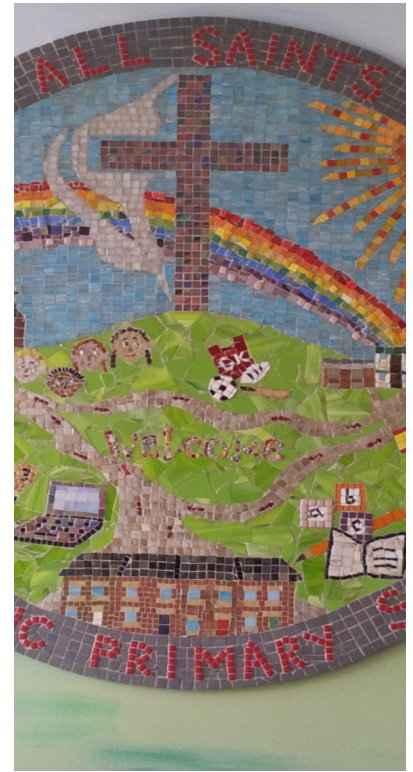
1. Check the privacy settings on all your devices and applications

4. Only allow your child to access age-appropriate material. The PEGI rating system is used to ensure the content is suitable for the age group labelled. E.g. Grand Theft Auto = 18 (contains extreme violence)
