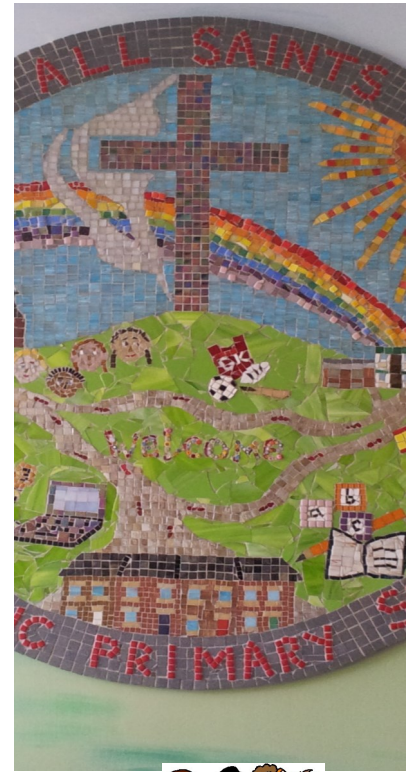
St Vincent's Partnership
