Congratulations to class 1H who were the only class to achieve our 96% attendance target for the Autumn term. Classes R1, \$2, 2S, 4S and 6M were very close with attendance 95%+. We are working closely with our school Education Welfare Officer because our overall school attendance for Autumn term was only 94.8%. Please make every effort to improve attendance in the Spring term.

Congratulations to 104 pupils who achieved 100% attendance for the whole Autumn Term and a further 54 pupils who achieved 100% attendance for the second half of the Autumn term.
