LFC morning club, Y2 after school football and Cross country will all be cancelled until after Christmas. All of the clubs will start again after the Christmas break.

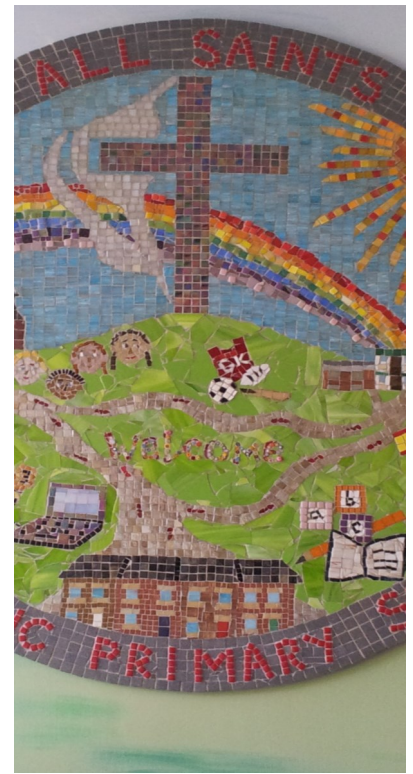
There will be no after-school football on Tuesday 29th due to the team having a match.

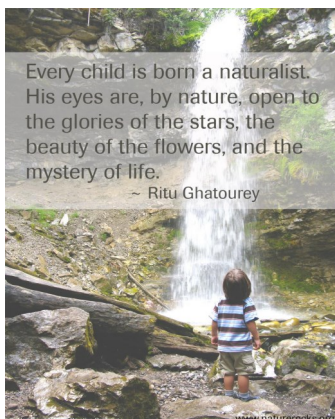
