Safer Internet Day

Tuesday 6th February is **Safer Internet Day**. At All Saints e-safety is a constant part of our curriculum, however, there will be a particular focus on Internet Safety on that day followed by an assembly on Thursday 8th February at 2.15pm to celebrate children's learning. Parents are invited to the assembly. Please take the opportunity to talk to your child about staying safe on line and check the privacy settings and parental controls on electronic devices used by your family. Also, please bear in mind that 13 yrs is the minimum age for accessing sites such as Instagram and Facebook. Many games such as Grand Theft Auto also have age restrictions. For the sake of your child's safety on-line, please make sure you comply with these age limits. Go to www.saferinternet.org.uk and look in the Parents and Carers section for helpful tips, advice, guides and resources to keep your child safe on line.

Safeguarding

We have had reports of a child at a Liverpool school being approached by a man in a car. Please remain vigilant and talk to your children about staying safe- don't talk to strangers. Remind children who walk to and from school without adult supervision to go straight to school/home, never accept lifts or talk to people they don't know.

There is always a member of staff at the playground gates in the morning and after school; please speak to them if you have any concerns.
