Fire Safety:

- To identify basic fire hazards.

- Begin to understand the importance a smoke alarm has in home fire safety
- To identify the function of a smoke alarm.
- To know they have to Shout, get out, call the brigade out and stay out if a fire happens.
- To know that if a person's clothes catch fire they should stop, drop and roll.
- To recognise the number 999.
- To understand they should say no if others want to play with fire
- To understand when it is appropriate to use the 999 emergency call system.
