

Starting school at All Saints Catholic Primary School 2022



Some points to remember...

We want your child to be happy and eager to start their new class. Please bear in mind the following points to help ensure a smooth transition into school.

Please speak to a member of staff if you have any questions or concerns.

- Tuesday 28th June and Wednesday 29th June Children will visit their new classes in groups of 6 in Hourly sessions from 9.00am – 3.00pm. You will have received a letter detailing the class, date and time of allocated time slot.
- Reception 1: Tuesday 28th June, Class Teacher Miss Mullally
- Reception 2: Wednesday 29th June, Class Teacher Miss Freckleton
- Children will start school on a part time basis on Monday 5th September 2022. Children born before the end of March 2018 will attend school in the morning and children born after March 2018 will attend the afternoon session.

Part time sessions: morning 8.30 - 11.30 a.m.

Part time sessions: afternoon 12.45 - 3.05 p.m.

- Children will attend school all day from Thursday 8th September. The reception classroom doors open 8.30 a.m.
- When children start full time on 8th September, they may have a school dinner or bring in a packed lunch.
- Uniform can be purchased from Miss Tierney. Uniform that can be bought from school includes – sweatshirts, coats, ties, and red homework bags, P.E. kit.
- P.E. kit, and pump bag can also be purchased from Lisa's Priory Road.
- Please ensure your child's uniform including P.E. kit, pump bag and coat is fully named.
- We encourage all children to bring a bottle of plain water into school every day – again please put your child's name on it.
- Please send all money into school in a named envelope. Money envelopes can be purchased from the school office.
- We ask for a voluntary school levy donation of £3.00 per half term, this is used to help with the cost of school trips, visits from Theatre Groups and the Archdiocesan building fund.
- Please contact the office for information concerning before and after school clubs.

- Please complete the emergency contact/medical information before September.
